







Top 10 U.S. Airports 2020 Total International Passengers to/from the U.S.










Top 10 U.S. Airports 2020 Total Overseas Passengers to/from the U.S.















Top 10 International Countries of Origin for Visitors to the U.S. in 2020 Total Arriving/Departing Passengers on International Flights



Top 10 International Countries visited by U.S. Residents 2020 Total Arriving/Departing Passengers on U.S. International Flights



U.S. Residents: Top 10 States of Residence for Passengers Arriving/Departing the U.S. on International Flights in 2020





U.S. Residents: Top 10 Metro Areas of Residence for Passengers Arriving/Departing the U.S. on International flights in 2020




- > Residents of New York City generated the largest volume of passengers arriving/departing the U.S. on international flights.






Top 10 States Visited by Non-U.S. Resident Passengers Arriving/Departing the U.S. on International Flights - 2020




- Florida was the highest ranked state destination reported by Non-U.S. residents arriving/departing the U.S. on international flights in 2020.



Airport Ratings: All U.S. Airports All Passengers Departing the U.S. on an International Flight - 2020




